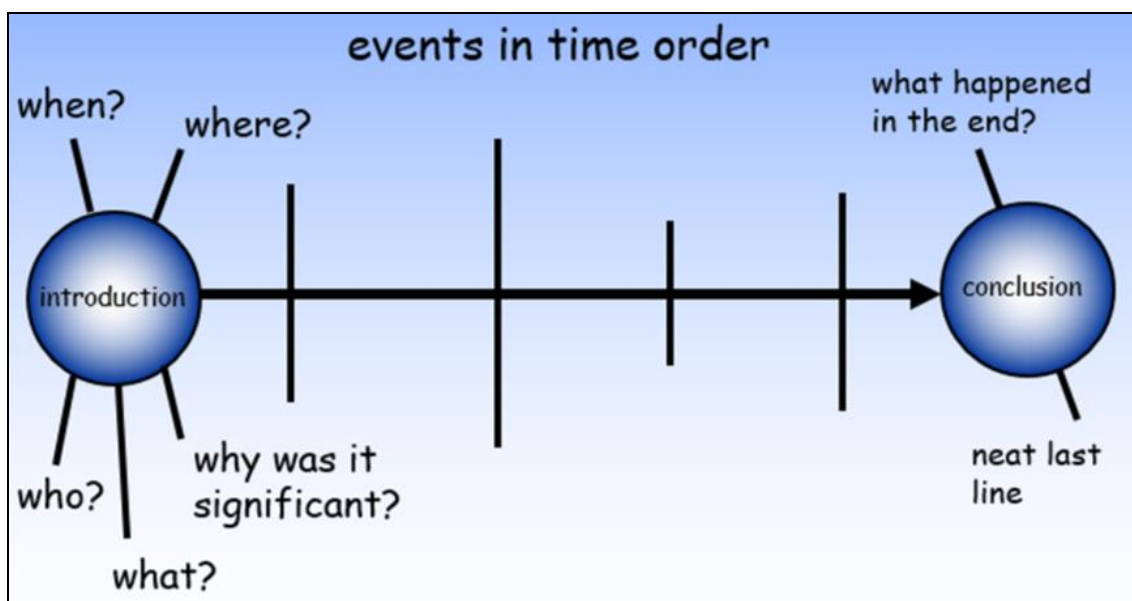


Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> May 2020 - Day 1

**LO: I can identify the key features of a newspaper report**
