LO: I can write a newspaper report

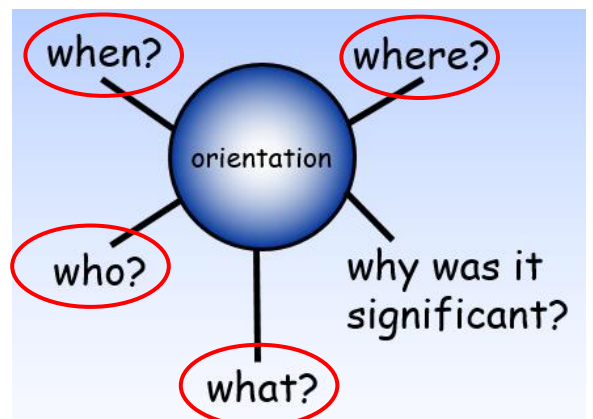
