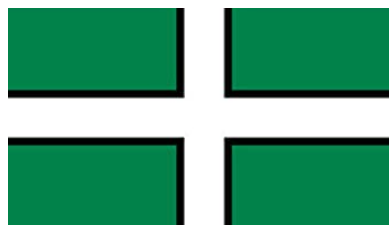


We're travelling to Uganda!
