PE Lesson:

Teach the children how to score in target games. Help them to understand that targets are for aiming at and the need for accuracy. Encourage them to explore different ways of sending balls using their hands and feet to aim for, and hit, a target. Allow time for children to practise kicking and throwing balls/beanbags at different types of targets - skittles, into hoops, into baskets, into nets, etc.

Help children to record their scores on the whiteboard.
