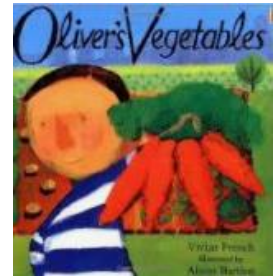


## Continuous provision learning grid

Focus text: Oliver's vegetables

Other focus: 2D and 3D shape

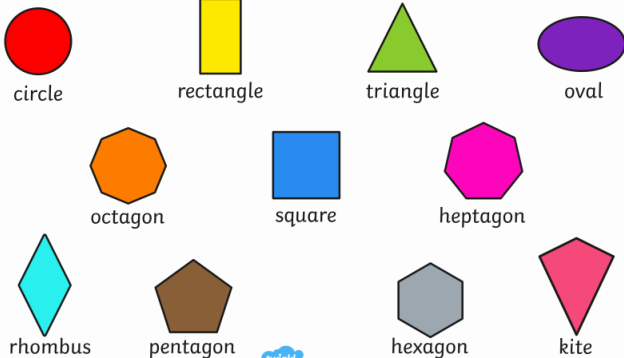


Below you will find a menu of activities which link to the continuous provision that is taking place in school.

Please feel free to pick and choose activities which you feel your child will enjoy.

<p>Use playdough to roll out snakes and then form shapes.</p> <p>Use shape cutters to explore shapes. Children could make their own playdough shape monster!</p>	<p>Make 2D and 3D shapes using art straws, playdough or glue and paper to create 2D shapes.</p> <p>Use the shape mats below to support you.</p>	<p>Children to chalk shapes on floor. Then use small pots of water and paintbrushes to trace over them and make them disappear.</p>
<p>Children can make stick puppets with characters from the book and use these in the puppet theatre/dolls house</p>	<p>On chalkboard/fence write tricky words (he, she, we, me) using chalk and have a paintbrush and water ready for the children to make them vanish</p>	<p>Use shape sponges, trays of paint, long strips of paper to make a shape pattern. Can the children name all of the shapes they have used?</p>
