Reading

Please log on to bug club

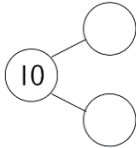
English

We are looking at information texts about whales. Can you find out some interesting facts about whales in books or by using the internet?

Maths

Have a hoop and 10 bean bags (or something similar). Take it in turns to throw the beanbags into the hoop.

Record scores as on a part-whole model (see below), with 10 in the whole. Show children that we could turn the part-whole model on its side and it would still show us what makes 10.



Write how many beanbags landed inside the hoop in one of the parts. Encourage children to help you fill in the other part by counting how many beanbags landed outside of the hoop.

Phonics

Recall the sounds: sh, ch, th, ng, ai, ee, igh, oa, oo/oo, ar, or

Revise: or/ar. Help your child to decode a list of words that contain or/ar. Use sound buttons. Fork, card, sort, born, hard, torn, park, car. Sort the words into sets or and ar.

Read the captions: Can you get the fork? A baby chick was born on the farm. Can you sort the books? I put on a hard hat. The dress was torn. I had a card. I went to the park. Get in the car.

PE

In gymnastics today we are practising different jumps including straight jumps, star jumps and half-turn jumps. Have a go at practising these at home and seeing if you can put them in to a short sequence (jump-balance-jump-balance-jump).
