PE Lesson: Ball Skills

Children are to explore different ways of using a ball eg. *bouncing a ball, passing it from hand to hand, around the body, through the legs, over the head, moving it with their feet or a stick, hitting it to a target*. Help them to find different ways to send a ball with their hands, eg *throwing, rolling, pushing*. Show them how to retrieve and stop a ball using different parts of the body. Allow time for children to practise sending and receiving balls.
