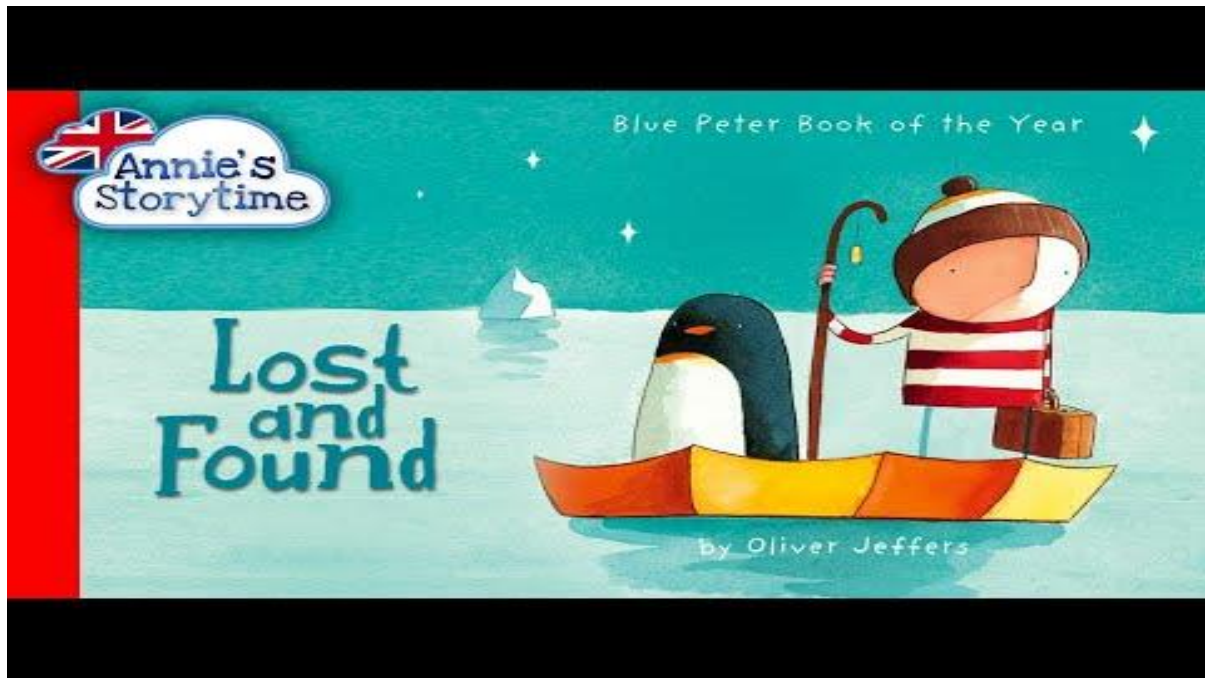


Continuous provision learning grid

Focus text: Lost and found [Lost and Found By Oliver Jeffers](#)



Below you will find a menu of activities which link to the continuous provision that is taking place in school.

Please feel free to pick and choose activities which you feel your child will enjoy.

Make your own story book using stapled paper.	Make snowy pictures using runny glue and glitter OR cold colour paint with sponges or bubble wrap and glitter and cotton wool.	Children to make playdough boat and children to use small people to tell a 'first, then, now' addition or subtraction story.
Create a Lost and Found small world story scene. You could include: blue material for sea, small boats, small world boys, penguins, duck, prop for iceberg egg polystyrene, south pole sign, house for boy.	Floating and sinking exploration - Children to explore which trays/tubs (use your recycling!) make the best boat. Discuss vocabulary 'floating/sinking' Challenge- how many people can you fit in your boat? Child could make a 'first, then and now' addition or subtraction story whilst playing with boats and people.	Using white, blue, purple paint and cotton wool buds can the children create pictures of snowflakes.
