## PE Lesson - Ball Skills

Warm up: Up and Down: Using balls move walking around carrying their ball in different ways (e.g. on shoulder, on tummy, on head etc.) into spaces, changing directions looking ahead. On command 'ball down,' children place their ball on the floor still, go and touch designated person or object and come back to collect their ball.

Revise bouncing a ball: Demonstrate bouncing the ball. Can they remember points from last session? Bounce with two hands, then collect/catch with two hands. Repeat. Bounce and move with two hands. Think about what makes a good performance. Where should you try to be looking- ahead of you! Move around bouncing the ball, looking up for spaces.

Hit the spot!: Mark out a cross in chalk or agree on a marking found on the ground. Children bounce their ball on the spot using two hands to gain one point. How many points can they score in one minute? Discuss good technique. Can

they beat their score? Play again but this time children bounce their balls to move their spot to a different agreed spot.
