Phonics:	<p>Please access phonics play by using the details sent to you.</p> <p>We are currently recapping Phase 5 sounds and looking at alternative sounds. Use flash cards, tricky word trucks, picnic on Pluto and 5a sentences to consolidate all sounds.</p> <p>https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/</p>
English:	<p>We are currently looking at what is a recount and we are going to write one of our own.</p> <p>Today you need to write your last two sentences of your recount. It is always best to orally rehearse them first to remind you of what you need to write. Check out the "Helpful Hints" poster in case you need a reminder of what needs to be included in a recount.</p>
Reading	<p>Please read for 10 minutes. You can access books on your bug club account.</p>
Maths	<p>Today and tomorrow we are problem solving with fractions. Answer the questions in the booklet by unpicking the maths. This will take two mornings as some of the maths we haven't seen represented in this way. For example;</p> $8 \times 5 = 40$ <p>However, we know how to count in 5s so your grown up can help to explain what that representation means.</p>
Year 1 leavers disco!	<p>This afternoon we are celebrating a very tough year. We are going to play games like musical statues, and musical bumps. If you would like to join us, send in a dojo message and we can connect you via Zoom.</p>
