Phonics:	<p>Please access phonics play by using the details sent to you.</p> <p>We are currently recapping Phase 5 sounds and looking at alternative sounds. Use flash cards, tricky word trucks, picnic on Pluto and 5a sentences to consolidate all sounds.</p> <p>https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/</p>
English:	<p>We are currently innovating the story of Tiddler. Please use the story map provided to orally rehearse the beginning of the story. We usually put actions to the words to help us remember the sentences.</p> <p>C – Clippers the crab</p> <p>Mr Shark</p> <p>Playing with a killer whale</p> <p>Dancing with a turtle</p> <p>Blowing bubbles with a puffer fish</p>
Reading	<p>Please read for 10 minutes. You can access books on your bug club account.</p>
Maths	<p>We are learning about position movement and direction. We have been looking at whole, half, quarter and three quarter turns. See if you can use action figures or cuddly toys to demonstrate them turning clockwise. Take some pictures and send them in!</p>

PE:	<p>Today we would be taking part in our annual sports day event. Maybe you could create something at home together with grown-ups and siblings, to feel like you are still taking part. Here are the activities that we would be doing:</p> <p>Sprint – practise running short distances</p> <p>Target throw - throwing an object into a bucket from varying distances,</p> <p>Sack race - practise jumping with two feet together</p> <p>Egg and spoon race – good luck if you choose to use a real egg!</p>
