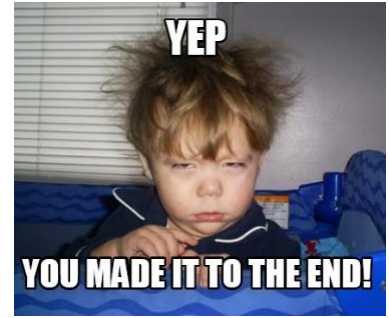


Friday 5th March

Maths: A fractions game to play! See board on website.:

Instructions 2 players

1. Choose a player to roll the dice first
2. The player rolls then slides the dice together to make a fraction (the smallest number is the numerator)
3. The player covers the fraction with their colour counter
4. The next player rolls and repeats steps 2-3. If the fraction is already covered the player loses that turn.
5. The winner is the player with the most fractions covered!
