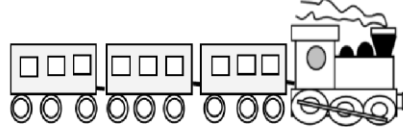


Spotting Vowel Phonemes

Read each piece of writing and underline the named vowel phonemes.

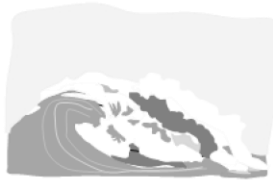
Long a sounds

Read each piece of writing and underline the named vowel phonemes.

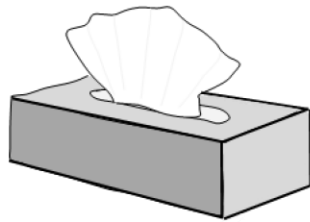
Long o sounds
