1. Jane thinks that each person at her party will eat 5 biscuits each. There will be 6 people how many biscuits will she need.

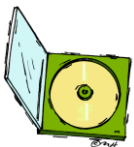


2. There are 8 sparklers in a box. Sam has 5 boxes. How many sparklers does he have altogether?

7. Tom has 5 friends over for tea. They have 4 fish fingers each. How many fish fingers does

Tom's Dad have to buy for his friends?



8. Sally gives out 12 party bags at the end of her party. Inside each party bag are 5 balloons. How many balloons does Sally give out?
