Phonics : To revise our recent work on suffixes, look at the powerpoint on the website and play the 'Kim's game' type activity to match the words.

Here are the instructions from the powerpoint:

This game can be played with individuals or two teams taking turns to find a matching pair.

Step One: Show the children the cards on the tray.

Step Two: Allow the children a set amount of time to memorise the cards.

Step Three: Click on the cards to hide them.

Step Four: Children pick two cards to click on and reveal.

Step Five: If they are a matching pair, they score a point.

Step Six: If they are not a matching pair, click on the cards again to hide them.
