Key skills (everyday tasks)

Practise this week's **spellings** – definite, desperate, dictionary

These are spellings from the Y5/6 spelling list that have unstressed vowels (vowels which are in the spelling but not heard clearly when you say them)

Word of the day- resilience What does the word mean? Can you use it in a sentence? Can you find synonyms (words or phrases that mean the same thing)? Can you find antonyms (words that mean the opposite)?

English- You are writing a description of a setting today. You can use the images of different settings on the website to describe or you can describe your own setting.

Science- Could you please produce something to show what you have learnt so far about separating materials. It could be a double page spread, a poster, a PowerPoint or even a video.
