LO: I can plan a diary entry

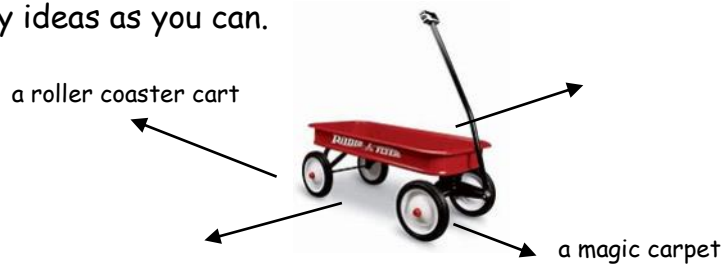
At the end of 'Taking Flight', Tony's Dad is reminded of the wagon he enjoyed as a child. How do you think it made him feel?
