Enjoy the story Me Jane...

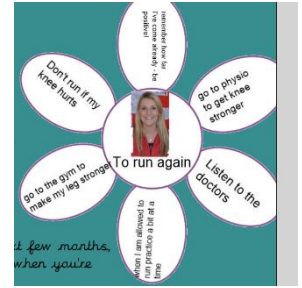

Next, in the middle of the flower write a dream or goal that you want to achieve.

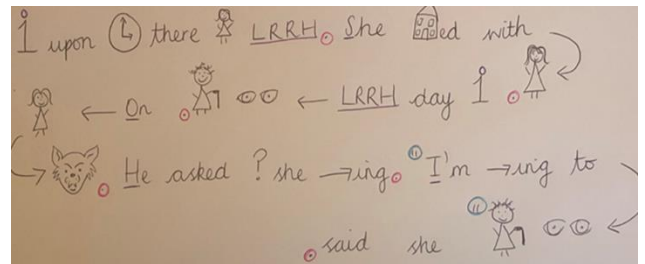
Then, on each petal of the flower write down all the things you will have to do to achieve your goal/dream.

It might be something you want to achieve in the next few months, few years or it might be something you want to do when you're older. You can do more than one if you wish.

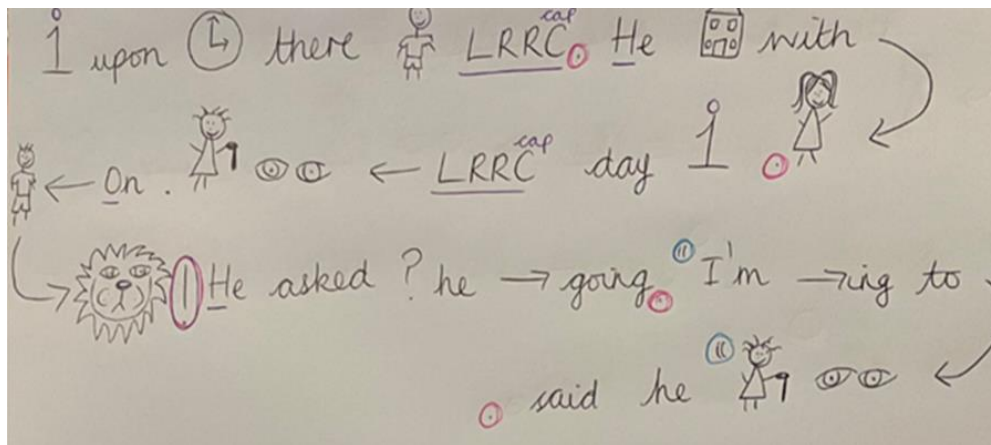


English
