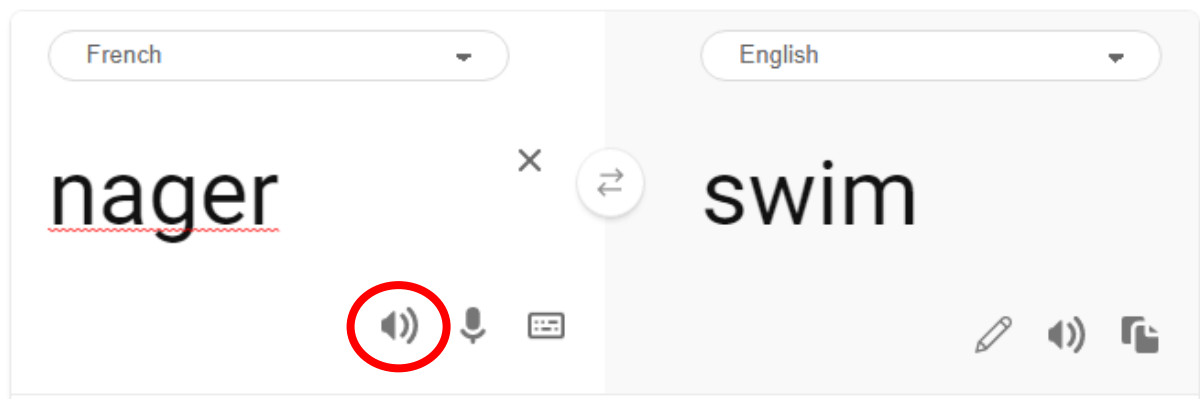
1. How old is Justin?
