<i>completely</i>	<i>gently</i>	<i>dramatically</i>
<i>usually</i>	<i>humbly</i>	<i>simply</i>
<i>finally</i>	<i>nobly</i>	<i>accidentally</i>
<i>comically</i>	<i>basically</i>	<i>actually</i>
<i>happily</i>	<i>frantically</i>	<i>occasionally</i>
<i>angrily</i>	<i>actual</i>	<i>basic</i>
<i>complete</i>	<i>simple</i>	<i>happy</i>
<i>gentle</i>	<i>humble</i>	<i>frantic</i>

The suffix **-ly** starts with a consonant letter, so it is added straight on to **most** root words

If the root word ends in **-y** with a **consonant** letter before it, the **y** is changed to **i**.

But only if the root word has more than one syllable e.g. angry-angrily

If the root word ends with **-le**, the **-le** is changed to **-ly**.
e.g. humble-humbly, gentle-gently

If the root word ends with **-ic**,
-ally is added rather than just **-ly**,
