How to make perfect pancakes

You will need:

- **Toppings of your choice!**

Equipment:

A mixing bowl, a spoon, a cup, a plate and a frying pan.

What to do:

1. **the flour into the mixing bowl.**
2. **the two eggs into a cup and them.**
3. **the beaten eggs and the milk into the flour.**
4. **it well until all the flour has combined.**
5. **on the hob to a low heat as we don't want to burn the mixture.**
6. **a little butter in the frying pan but be careful not to burn yourself.**
7. **enough mixture into the pan to make a thin pancake.**
8. **or the pancake over to cook the other side.**
9. **the pancake on a plate when it is golden.**
10. **on your favourite topping.**
11. **your perfect pancakes but don't forget to do the !**
