Maths lesson (45 minutes)

We have been using the adjusting method in maths this week. Earlier this week you watched a BBC bite size video about rounding to the nearest multiple of ten.

Today, we would like you to design a make a game based on the adjusting method.

Here are some suggestions:

Finally, test your game out with everyone at home!

English (30 minutes)

Today we will be writing using subordinating conjunctions. Use the conjunctions list you wrote down yesterday to write some expanded sentences. Look out the window for inspiration to write sentences about.

'Two birds were perched on the fence until the cat came along.'

'Suddenly, the cat jumps up because he thinks he can catch them.'

Spelling (15 minutes)

Go on a spelling hunt. This could be around your house or whilst on a walk. Write down any spelling that looks like it might be tricky to spell. Find at least 5 tricky words?

You might find them on books, street names, shop names, signposts, calendars, food packets to name a few!
