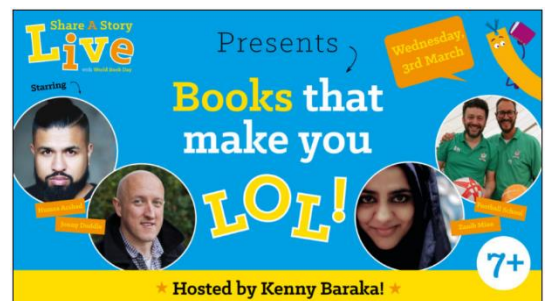
### Reading (45 minutes)
