<b>Making the food</b>	<p>Prepare the mini paddling pools</p> <p>Open tin and box of food</p> <p>Put food and water into mini paddling pools. Use spades.</p>	<p>What is the food put in?</p> <p>How will you open the food?</p> <p>How is the food going to be put into the container?</p>	<p>A container the size of a trampoline.</p> <p>Open dino-proof the lid</p> <p>Put the food in with a ladder</p>
<b>Putting the food down</b>	<p>They are excited. Dinosaur is jumping.</p> <p>Call dinosaur in</p> <p>Put food on the floor</p>	<p>How is your dinosaur feeling?</p> <p>What is your dinosaur doing to show this?</p> <p>Where is the food going to be put?</p>	<p>Hungry</p> <p>Pointing its foot at the container</p> <p>It is on legs (like a trampoline).</p>
<b>Eating the food</b>	<p>Watch your dinosaur eat</p> <p>Re-fill the bowl with dry Dino Much</p> <p>Gobbles it up</p>	<p>What does the dinosaur do now?</p> <p>What are you re-filling the bowl with?</p> <p>What does your dinosaur do with the next piece food (synonym)?</p>	<p>The dinosaur feeds its self.</p> <p>Its legs stretch into the container and he eats some of the food.</p> <p>More crushed candy.</p> <p>Nibbles.</p>
<b>Making a mess</b>	<p>Food goes everywhere!</p> <p>Dino runs around licking food off things.</p>	<p>How does the room get messy?</p> <p>What does the dinosaur do in response?</p>	<p>If the dinosaur accidently bites a hole in the container the food floods out.</p> <p>The dinosaur points at the mess with its foot. Sad face.</p>
<b>Cleaning up</b>	<p>Let them share a drink with you</p> <p>While he finishes the drink clean up.</p>	<p>How do you calm the dinosaur down?</p> <p>What are you doing with the mess?</p>	<p>Give them a lolly pop</p> <p>Patch the hole and put the food back in the container.</p>
<b>Conclusion</b>	<p>No longer hungry</p> <p>Time to play games.</p>	<p>Have you fulfilled the instructions?</p> <p>What could you do next?</p>	<p>Yes. The dinosaur is not hungry.</p> <p>Continue playing.</p>
