

3) LO: To investigate *-ly* suffix

<i>complete</i>	<i>humble</i>	<i>dramatic</i>
<i>usual</i>	<i>noble</i>	<i>simple</i>
<i>final</i>	<i>basic</i>	<i>accident</i>
<i>comic</i>	<i>frantic</i>	<i>actual</i>
<i>happy</i>	<i>gentle</i>	<i>occasional</i>
<i>angry</i>		

The suffix *-ly* starts with a consonant letter, so it is added straight on to **most** root words

If the root word ends in *-y* with a **consonant** letter before it, the **y** is changed to **i**.

But only if the root word has more than one syllable e.g. angry-angrily

If the root word ends with **-le**, the **-le** is changed to **-ly**.
e.g. humble-humbly, gentle-gently

If the root word ends with **-ic**,
-ally is added rather than just **-ly**,
