English - Today we will be writing our stories based on 'The Catch'. Your teacher will send a pic of your plan to you via dojo.

All our English lessons this week are focused on drafting, editing and publishing our stories. Remember, this is your final piece of year 4 writing so try to showcase all of your skills!

Maths - This week, in our maths lessons, we are revisiting multiplication. Please watch, and join in with, [this lesson](#).

Reading - For your reading task today, I would like you to watch [this session](#). The focus is reading for pleasure.

Geography - As you know, we are half way through our piece of work comparing settlements (London and Exmouth). In class, we will be completing our posters showing similarities and differences. At home today, you can either start a new poster including as much info as you can remember from our lesson last week, or, carry out some research to compare the settlements (e.g. population size)

French - For our final French lesson of the year, we are thinking about towns and cities in France. Your task is to find out the names of the five biggest cities / towns in France, find them on a map and find out if they are famous / known for something specific (e.g. a famous landmark, a particular food, a holiday destination etc).

You should create a fact file for each city to present your findings.
