God is the Creator of the universe.	Science describes the Big Bang as the most likely explanation of the start of the universe.
The narrative in Genesis 1 is true but not literally true: it contains truths about what God is like.	The Genesis narrative is not true: how could light come before the sun? How could the universe be created in six days – it took billions of years!
Genesis 1 is a magnificent poem and describes what some people think about God.	Genesis 1 is an important religious text but it does not describe the way the world actually began.
I believe God created the world from nothing, but not in six days. This poem shows God's power but not God's methods.	Science has all the answers.
Science answers 'how' questions: religion answers 'why' questions.	The universe is an amazing place.
For as long as humans have been around, they have looked for explanations for the world and for life.	Religion is make-believe.
