Find an empty jar and decorate it any way you would like. <p><u>Science</u></p>  <p>What affect does temperature have on the time it takes a material to dissolve? Make a prediction. Choose a soluble material - salt, sugar, coffee or a jelly cube! Record the temperature (if you can) and the time it takes to dissolve.          Try the experiment using different water temperatures. <u>Do ask an adult to help you with any hot water.</u> You could use the table in our Year 5 folder to present your findings.</p>	<p><u>History</u></p>  <p>Enjoy this lively BBC podcast about <a href="#">The Space Race</a>*with Greg Jenner (from Horrible Histories).
