# Do They Rhyme?

## Phonics activities for Reception children:

Please use your letters and laminated sheet to play sound swap with your child with the words [bet](#)  
[bit](#) [fit](#) [fin](#)

Ask your child to build the word "bet" and write this word underneath.

Ask your child which sound they need to swap to make the word "bit" (your child should change the e for i).

Ask your child to write the new word. They then need to read the new word b-i-t bit

Ask your child which sound they would need to swap to make the word "fit" (your child should change the b for f).

Ask your child to write the new word. They then need to read the new word f- i-t fit

Finally, ask your child which sound they need to swap to make the word "fin" - (your child should change the t for n).

Ask your child to write the new word. They then need to read the new word f - i - n - fin

## Nursery and Reception children Maths:

We have been learning about the 2d shapes- circle, triangle, square and oblong.

Can you be a shape hunter? Go around your house looking for these shapes. Draw what you find and talk about the shapes using the vocabulary 'sides' and 'corners.'
