

EYFS Home Learning – 28.1.22

Sorry you can't be in class with us today.

Below are some activities linked to the learning we will be doing in school.

Phonics:	Please practise previously taught sounds – see Tapestry. This week we are practising reading and writing words made up of 4 sounds. We will be building the words kept, left, nest . Your child is to use the sound cards you have at home to build these words. Make sure they say the sounds as they build the word. They are then to practise writing these words. Again, encourage your child to say the sounds as they write them. Challenge: Try and write the sentence: I help the ant.
English:	LO: I can re-tell a story I am familiar with. Read Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=cRAAQ8EWzig Ask your child to look at the 4 pictures from the story (see resources). Ask them to try and put them in the correct order. Once they have done this, ask them to try and re-tell the story using the language, First, Next, Then, Finally.
Reading:	Read for at least 10 minutes the decodable book you have been sent home.
Maths:	Look at the Part Part Whole model (in resources) – use 8 objects. Children are to rehearse ___ is a part ___ is a part and the whole amount is 8. Make all the ways to make 8. Demonstrate how we can record this as a number sentence. How many ways can we record?
Understanding the World:	Fill up a tub with water and explore which objects float and which objects sink. Do you notice a pattern of which materials sink or float? Are they similar shapes? Or sizes?
