Ticket to Uganda Day

Sorry you can't be in class with us today.

Below are some activities linked to the learning we will be doing in school.

Phonics:	<p>Please practise previously taught sounds – see Tapestry.</p> <p>This week we are practising reading and writing words made up of 4 sounds. We will be building the words best, desk, help. Your child is to use the sound cards you have at home to build these words. Make sure they say the sounds as they build the word. They are then to practise writing these words. Again, encourage your child to say the sounds as they write them.</p> <p>Challenge: Try and write the sentence: The best desk is red.</p>
English:	<p>LO: To articulate their ideas clearly using a complete sentence.</p> <p>Read Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers.</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=cRAAQ8EWzig</p> <p>Ask your child to pretend they are packing a suitcase to visit the South Pole. They have to choose 3 things to take with them. Encourage them to say a complete sentence. For example, 'I would take a woolly hat because it will keep my head warm'.</p>
Reading:	<p>Reading Read for at least 10 minutes the decodable book you have been sent home.</p>
Understanding the World Uganda	<p>Throughout the day the children will be engaged in some activities to support their understanding of how Patricia lives in Uganda.</p> <p>The children will be wearing Red, Black and Gold – to represent the colours of the Uganda Flag</p> <p>The children will be learning Acholi. Please watch this video https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WK8LlgtXhJc</p> <p>They will be using clay to make bandas (houses) – please use playdough, if you have some at home.</p> <p>The children will also be making footballs out of thin plastic bags by moulding a piece of newspaper or cloth in a ball and then wrapping it in plastic bags and securing with elastic bands.</p> <p>Please also look at where Uganda is on a map/ globe</p>
