

## EYFS Home Learning - 5.01.22

Sorry you can't be in class with us today.

Below are some activities linked to the learning we will be doing in school.

Phonics:	<p>This week we are revisiting all the sounds we have previously learnt. Please see Tapestry for the correct pronunciation.</p> <p>Please practise all these sounds.</p> <p>We will be building the words <b>zig, zag, zip</b> Your child is to use the sound cards you have at home to build these words.</p> <p>Make sure they say the sounds as they build the word. They are then to practise writing these words. Again, encourage your child to say the sounds as they write them.</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> Try and read and then write the sentence <b>Dan got a pet. It is a pup.</b></p>
English:	<p><a href="https://youtu.be/XdXzKvA-7qM">https://youtu.be/XdXzKvA-7qM</a></p> <p><b>LO: To show interest in different occupations</b></p> <p>Listen to the book called 'Busy People: Doctor' using the YouTube link above.</p> <p>Can you remember the different jobs the doctor had to do? Have you ever been to the doctors or the hospital? Why did you need to go? How did the doctor make you better?</p>
Reading	<p>Read for at least 10 minutes the decodable book you have been sent home.</p>
Maths	<p><b>LO: Practise counting forwards to 20.</b></p> <p>Warm up: <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=MVzXKfr6e8">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=MVzXKfr6e8</a></p> <p>Practise counting to 20. Putting arms in the air at each multiple of 10.</p> <p>Sit in a circle with the people in your house - count around the circle with each person saying the next number - when you get to a multiple of ten - everyone raise their hands.</p>
UW: Science	<p><b>LO: Explore the natural world around them</b></p> <p>Collect some small pots and small items, eg leaves, stones, fir cones. Put an item in each pot and fill them with water. Put the pots in the freezer to make some ice. Spend time exploring and playing with the ice. What does it feel like? What is happening to the ice? How can we get the object out of the ice?</p>
