

EYFS Home Learning - 6.01.22

Sorry you can't be in class with us today.

Below are some activities linked to the learning we will be doing in school.

Phonics:	<p>This week we are revisiting all the sounds we have previously learnt. Please see Tapestry for the correct pronunciation.</p> <p>Please practise all these sounds.</p> <p>We will be building the words wet, web, win. Your child is to use the sound cards you have at home to build these words.</p> <p>Make sure they say the sounds as they build the word. They are then to practise writing these words. Again, encourage your child to say the sounds as they write them.</p> <p>Challenge: Try and read and then write the sentence The pup ran in wet mud.</p>
English:	<p>LO: To write my name practising the correct letter formation.</p> <p>Practise writing your name 5 times on a piece of paper.</p>
Reading	<p>Read for at least 10 minutes the decodable book you have been sent home.</p>
Maths	<p>LO: Practise counting backwards from 20.</p> <p>Warm up: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=srPkt4k_O8</p> <p>Practise counting back from 20. Putting arms in the air at each multiple of 10.</p> <p>Sit in a circle with the people in your house - count back around the circle with each person saying the next number - when you get to a multiple of ten - everyone raise their hands.</p>
PSHE	<p>LO: To keep on trying when faced with a challenge.</p> <p>Set yourself a hard challenge like standing on one leg for 1 minute; building a tower from playing cards.</p> <p>How did you find that challenge? How did it make you feel? Was it easy?</p> <p>Listen to the YouTube story below about not giving up when faced with a challenge.</p> <p>https://youtu.be/KIva59P4HiY</p> <p>Talk together about how sometimes we may come across things that are difficult. Discuss how we could over come them, working together, not giving up, etc.</p> <p>If we were to do the challenges again, what could we do to help us achieve them? How do you sort out problems?</p>
