What Are We Learning?

We are learning how to count actions or objects which cannot be moved.

How to Set up the Challenge

- Take a look at the house picture on the other side of this page. You could also draw your own picture with other amounts of items up to ten.
- Talk about the picture together - what can you see in the picture? How many birds are there? How many windows?

How to Get Your Child Thinking

- How did you make sure you counted all the windows?
- Are you sure you counted all the birds?
How could we check?
- Have a go at counting the pictures too, making deliberate mistakes, such as:
 - counting at a different speed to which you point;
 - counting each object a second time;
 - saying the counting words in the wrong order or missing some out.

Can the child spot these and check to find the correct amount?

- Can you count the windows on the house?
- Can you count the people in the picture?
- Can you count the birds in the picture?
- What else can you count in the picture?
