Please remember to use the independent writing folder. When the children are writing independently I often create a word mat with specific words that I do not expect them to be able to spell at this point. I have provided an example of this, based upon the story of "Simon the Clumsy Dog". You may want to do this with your child before writing.

Phonics - Due to no screen time we have noted that there will be no live phonics session today. You could look for things around the house starting with different sounds, you could make words out of Play Doh, you could paint smile stones with words on. You could play Pictionary or even complete a word search.

Gymnastics - This half term we are developing the gymnastics skills that we acquired last half term. I appreciate this may be tricky as we don't want the children completely wrecking the house, however we have been mainly focussing on mastering balancing (two and one footed) and mastering using space well. You could incorporate these things when you go out for your daily exercise, playing games like hide and seek together to use the space appropriately, or walking along bridges, logs, using your balance.
