Phonics:	<p>Please access phonics play by using the details sent to you.</p> <p>We are currently recapping Phase 5 sounds and looking at alternative sounds. Use flash cards, tricky word trucks, picnic on Pluto and 5a sentences to consolidate all sounds.</p> <p>https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/</p>
English:	<p>We are currently looking at the suffix er and est. Use the PowerPoint provided to see examples of how the root word changes, and see if you find er or est words in a story book.</p>
Reading	<p>Please read for 10 minutes. You can access books on your bug club account.</p>
Maths	<p>We are learning about fractions. Find something that you can use in your home to cut into halves and quarters – we are going to use Play Doh. See if you can make equal pieces, and what happens when you don't!</p>
History	<p>Time Traveller Timmy is back to ask another question about an event in your living memory. Timmy has asked lots of questions about what it has been like to experience living with Covid-19 and today he wants to know: "What did you do to keep yourself busy whilst in lockdown?"</p> <p>In class, we are going to video each other's answers – similar to a news interview. You can do the same, or write a simple sentence explaining some of the fun things you did during lockdown.</p>
