HOME LEARNING

Reading – Children should aim to read for 15-20 daily. This may be reading to an adult or independent reading. Please record reading in the green reading record.

Spelling – This week we have been investigating the different spellings for the 'u' sound. Your spellings this week are: Monday, luck, cousin, sunlight, won

Maths – Activities will be set on MyMaths each week to follow up in class learning or revisit key skills. Children should spend no longer than 30 minutes per week on these tasks. This week, there are tasks based on finding the difference and mixed sums over 100.
