HOME LEARNING

Reading – Children should aim to read for 15-20 daily. This may be reading to an adult or independent reading. Please record reading in the green reading record.

Spelling – This week we have been investigating the /ee/ sound and the different ways it can be spelt. Your spellings this week are: breathe, beanbag, disagree, bumblebee and copycat.

Maths – Activities will be set on MyMaths each week to follow up in class learning or revisit key skills. Children should spend no longer than 30 minutes per week on these tasks. This week, there are tasks based on revisiting multiplication strategies, which will help consolidate their learning from this week.

Times tables – Times tables are key to so many areas of maths so we would like the children to try to spend a little bit of time practising regularly – every day if possible! This could be 5 minutes on TTrackstars, quick-fire questions, games such as tables bingo, or any other way you can think of to practise!
