HOME LEARNING

Reading – It has been brilliant to see lots of comments in reading diaries this week. Keep up the good work. When you are reading can you think how to answer one or two of the following retrieval questions about what you have read?

- How would you describe this story/text?
- What genre is it? How do you know?
- Whose perspective is this story told from?

Maths – Next week we are going to be learning about three-digit numbers and place value. Use this task to review your learning from Year 2 about tens and ones. This will set you up brilliantly for our next unit!

Times tables – We are continuing to develop our fluency and accuracy with the two and ten times tables. Please carry on practising on TT Rockstars. We will be on the look out for the most improved player!

Optional Extras – This week we have been learning about using art to represent a sound. Can you make any marks to represent a sound that you have heard.
