



*Some of the things I will be learning this term:*

We have a whole range of learning waiting for us this term! In our ENGLISH lessons, we will be starting with some persuasive writing (linked to spy gadgets!) before moving on to learn about different types of writing across the term. In our MATHS lessons, we have a BIG focus on multiplication. Our GEOGRAPHY skills will be developed through a country study where we will be focusing on France. This links with our continued learning in our FRENCH lessons. This term we will be creating sentences using the vocabulary we have been learning so far this year. Sticking with the French theme, in our ART lessons, we are using the French artist Henri Matisse as inspiration for our painting and colour mixing work. We know lots of our Year 4 learners particularly enjoy our SCIENCE lessons, and this term we will be learning all about states of matter and sound.
