HOME LEARNING

Reading – Children should read at home for 20-30 mins daily. This may be reading to an adult or independent reading.

We ask that all children focus on the facts that they are less confident with. There are lots of websites to help with practicing table facts. We will be picking up children who are less confident in school to boost their recall too.
