

Christmas phonics homework

Please find attached a set of flashcards for you to use with your child over the holidays. It would be really useful if you could spend time going through these with your child, two weeks can be a long time for the children not to do any phonics at this stage.

If you cut out the flashcards along the dotted lines and fold along the solid lines then you should end up with the words with the sounds on the back so that your child can read the sound then turn it over for them to 'say the sounds, read the word'.

Your child might like to practise writing the words or sorting the words into their sounds. You may also find other words with the same spellings of the sound.

The red spellings of the sounds are the ones that they year 1s have been exposed to so far this year, the blue ones are the year 2 ones. **Therefore year 1s do not yet need to do the blue spellings.**
