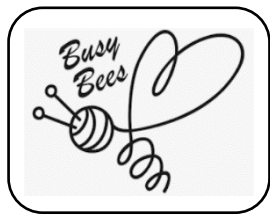


Year 1/2 News

HOME LEARNING

Reading

- Reading books will be changed every Tues & Fri, but we read with different groups throughout the week so please ensure book bags, reading records and books are in school every day! Please remember that the phonic book which is sent home is not progressive, it is a text that will include our focus sound spellings in words. Sometimes the text might be tricky for your child – please don't worry but share it with your child -ask them to spot/pick out the different sound spellings or just look at one or 2 pages – we do not expect them to always be able to read all the texts!
- Children should aim to read at home for 15-20mins daily. This may be reading to an adult or independent reading. Please record reading in the reading record, a date and/or quick comment is fine!

Maths –

We have focused on recognising and understanding 10, counting up to 10 (year 2 - 20) and making ten in different ways. We have used lots of different resources and images. Please encourage your child to practise correct formation of numerals 0-10 (see below trace then form independently). Please begin to support your child to recognise the words for numbers up to ten.

PHONICS FOCUS: Both Y1 & Y2 have been exploring different spellings of the 'ae' sound. Please find and discuss these in texts and books. Make a list of words, practise their spellings or write in a sentence.

Year 1: ai ay a-e ea

Year 2 : ai ay a-e ea ey ei eigh

Word of the Day

Each day in class, we focus on one 'Word of the Day'. These words are chosen in order to support children developing a wider vocabulary, help them access a text being used in reading lessons and encourage adventurous word choice when writing.

Next week, year 1/2 will be focusing on the following words:

One, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten

Perhaps your child will use some of these in conversations at home!
