**Spellings** – Please practise this week's spelling words: *teacher, scheme, history, mention, bawl, crescent, eighteen, regular, mane, disable*

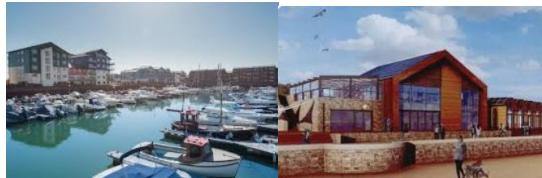
**Maths** – Please complete this week's maths homework
