## HOME LEARNING

**Reading** – Children are bringing home reading books. Children should aim to read at home for 15-20mins daily. If you have a query about your child's reading, please send a DOJO message or use the class email address. It is great to see so many children quizzing!

**Maths** – Have a go at using your knowledge of 'answering worded problems' to answer the questions below. Use the strategies we have been learning for the last few weeks!

**Times tables** – Before year 3 can begin looking at the 3, 4 and 8 times tables the children need to be confident with their 2, 5 & 10 times tables (including the inverse operations). Please practice these tables at home. Use <https://play.ttrockstars.com> to practice your speed and then try some missing number multiplications e.g.  $6 \times \_ = 12$   
Where possible we would love children to use the website and challenge themselves to improve their speed.

**Optional Extras** – There is no requirement to complete these tasks, they are entirely optional.

As part of our PE sessions we are working on throwing with accuracy through handball. Your child could create a poster to explain the rules of handball.
