HOME LEARNING

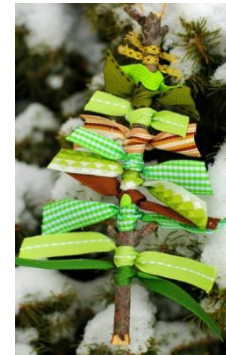
Reading –Please continue to read with your children every day. We will ensure that throughout next week the children come home with a new book or two for the holidays.
