HOME LEARNING

Maths

Year 1 – We have been exploring counting and grouping in 2's 5's and 10's. Can children continue this by collecting items in groups of these numbers (lego, pasta beads etc) How far can they count?!

Year 2 – Well done again for completing your SATS! We can now focus on deepening our amazing skills as we prepare for year three... This week, please could you look at adding and subtracting two 2-digit numbers (you can use this website to find some different questions; <https://www.math-salamanders.com/2-digit-addition-without-regrouping.html>)
