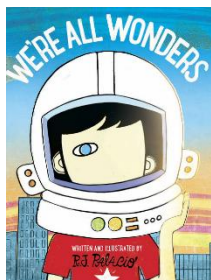


Year 1/2 News

Word of the Day

Each day in class, we focus on one 'Word of the Day'. These words are chosen in order to support children developing a wider vocabulary, help them access a text being used in reading lessons and encourage adventurous word choice when writing.

Perhaps your child will use some of these in conversations at home!

HOME LEARNING

Reading – Children should aim to read at home for 15-20mins daily. We are beginning a new reading text next week 'We're All Wonders'. We will be looking at the vocabulary used in the story as well as retrieval skills (finding the answers from within the text).

Maths –

Year 1 – We have been looking at measurement this week (cm) using cubes. Explore around your house for different items that you could measure and experiment what is longer, shorter, taller, heavier, lighter. Send any pictures in of your mathematical exploring around the house!

Year 2 – Quick recap of those 2, 5 and 10 times tables using TT Rockstars / Hit The Button. Revise equations using the 4 operations to calculate in preparation for our maths SATS questions (+ - x $\frac{\cdot}{\cdot}$)

Optional Extras – Following the Kings Coronation we know the children have learnt a lot over the last few weeks about the ceremony / symbols / objects involved. Watch this link

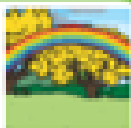

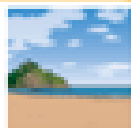

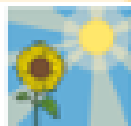
