Maths The children also need to log into TT Rockstars this week. There are also activities for the children to do on their LbQ platform for both Maths and Grammar.

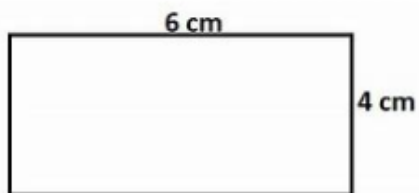
