





Can you remember these creatures? We learnt about them last term.

Notice that each noun has 'un' before it. What does this mean?

That's right, they are all masculine nouns.

Last term, we gave more information about the noun by including adjectives to describe the colour of each creature, e.g. un chat bleu. We noticed that, unlike in English, the colour came after the noun.

Today we are learning two new adjectives and these are unusual in French as they come before the noun.
